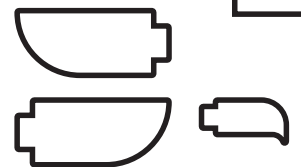
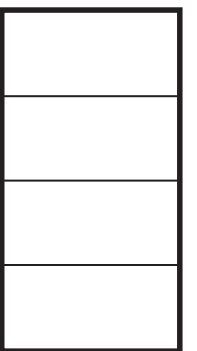


BUILD A TOTEM INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1

Print the artwork out using 11x17 paper. Following the crop marks, cut-out the main artwork. For best results use an x-acto knife to trim out all artwork.

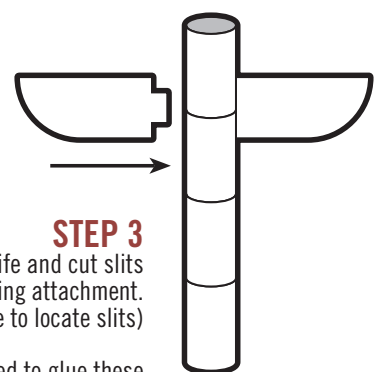
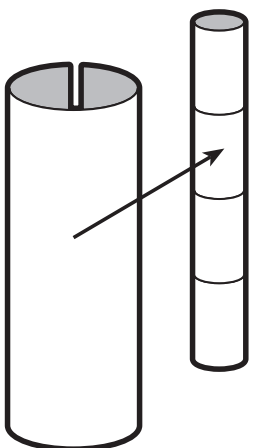
Spray mount the wing art to thin cardboard sheets and then cut out each of the shapes making sure to include the tabs. For the beak you don't need to mount on cardboard, just glue together each side of the beak and then trim out. This is easiest done using a light table to register each side.



STEP 2

Take main artwork image and wrap around paper towel tube and glue it into place. For best results we suggest you use spray-mount to secure your artwork to the tube.

Lay the art out flat, align tube to one end of the artwork and slowly roll the tube wrapping the art as you go. Take your time to avoid creasing and air pockets. Once in place press on to secure it and prevent peeling.



STEP 3

Take x-acto knife and cut slits for beak and wing attachment. (See template to locate slits)

You don't need to glue these they'll stay in place via friction but you can if you want to.
