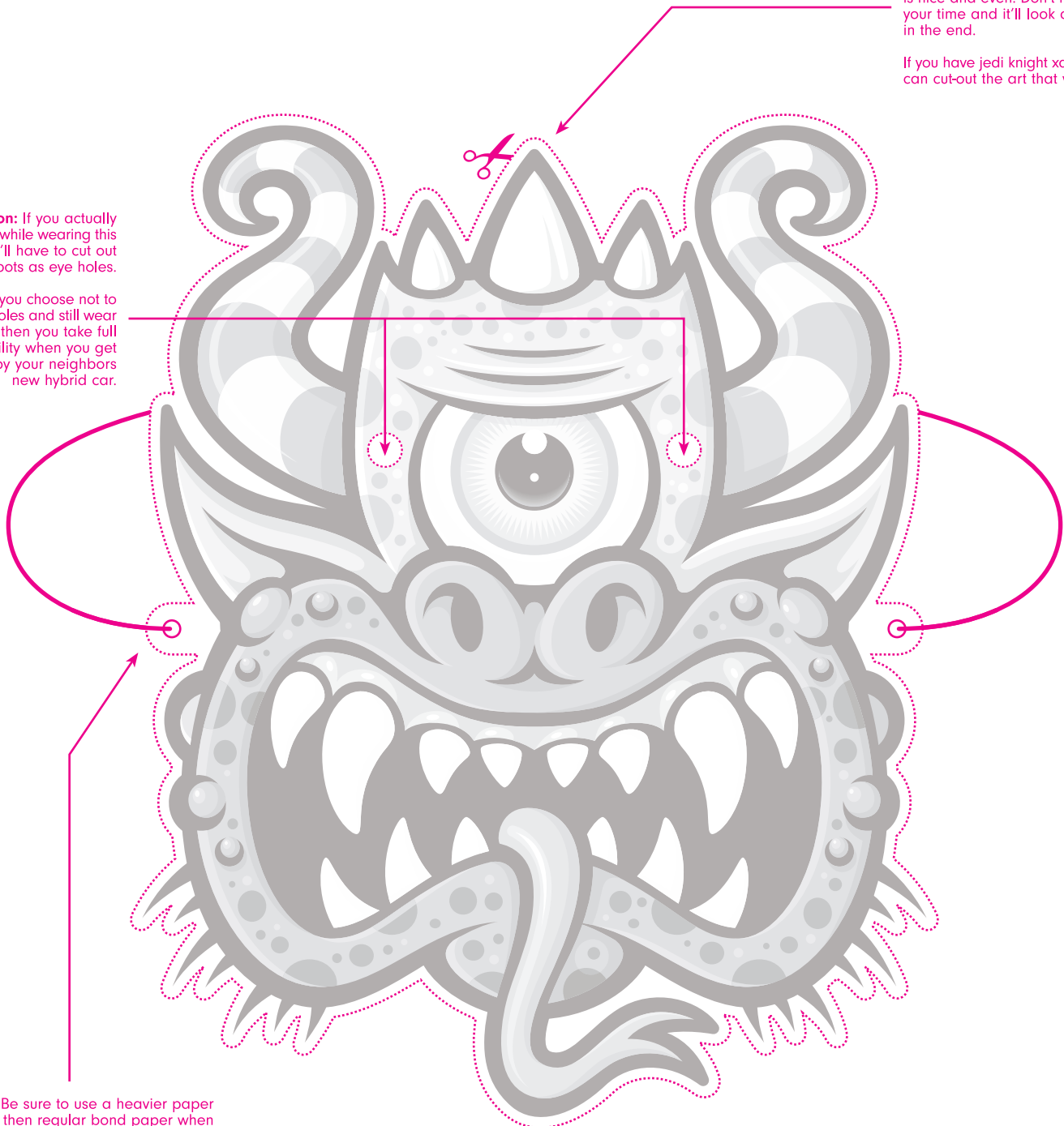
Snilbog™ Mask Instructions

Precision: Take your time to cut out the mask so the outer white border is nice and even. Don't rush this, take your time and it'll look a lot cleaner in the end.

If you have jedi knight xacto skills you can cut-out the art that way too.

Suggestion: If you actually want to see while wearing this mask you'll have to cut out these two spots as eye holes.

Warning: If you choose not to cut-out the holes and still wear the mask then you take full responsibility when you get ran over by your neighbors new hybrid car.



Printing: Be sure to use a heavier paper stock rather than regular bond paper when printing out the mask art. Or if you do print it out on bond paper spray mount it to a heavier paper stock.

Construction: Use the tabs to attach your string or elastic band. If you just want to print and cut-out the art just trim off the tabs.

You could also use this 'Mardi Gras' style. Just cut-out the art, trim off the tabs and mount it onto a flat stick or dowelling.

If your dog permits, you could tape it to his head and freak out small children when they come knocking for candy.

What is a 'Snilbog'? They're hardly ever seen during the day unless of course you're home alone, the lights are turned off and you happen to venture into your dark and cold basement or crawl space.

Snilbog's enjoy using their forked tongue to probe the dirty ears of sleeping kids and then feasting on the hardened ear wax they find.
